Misinformation Grant Program:

The ABIM Foundation has launched a **Misinformation Challenge Grant program** designed to enhance or expand existing practices designed to build trust in the health care system by identifying and countering misinformation in health care and public health.

An independent panel of judges will select two winners, who will receive 2-year grants of \$80,000 (first place) or \$30,000 (second place). The first-place winner will have the opportunity to present at the 2022 ABIM Foundation Forum.
