HOW TO FIND A PRACTICUM SITE



1) <u>Discover your interests</u> <u>in public health</u>

The first step to finding a potential Practicum site is to understand your interests. This includes understanding your passions, location, workplace preferences, and key populations you may want to work with.



2) <u>Define your desired</u> <u>work capacities/functions</u>

Once you have established your interests, you need to define what type of work you want to engage in or find the most interesting. This is what will help make your Practicum tailored to your personal career goals.



3) <u>Find</u> <u>organizations/places</u> <u>of work and job titles</u> <u>that fit your work</u> <u>functions</u>
