### **OTHER REQUIREMENTS**

To meet the requirements of our accreditors and ensure that MD/MPH students demonstrate all foundational and program-specific competencies, MD/MPH students need to complete the following in addition to their coursework:

- Complete an online module on negotiation and mediation skills.
- Count 100 hours of their Population Health Summit towards their hourly requirements for the Applied Practice Experience (APEx). All other requirements, such as the submission of at least two deliverables demonstrating at least five competencies in service to a community site, are the same as other students.
- Integrate public health knowledge and individually submit an updated Population Health Proposal, originally produced during the Population Health Summit, for their MPH Culminating Experience (CE).
- Complete required Professional Enhancement (PE) hours, CITI training, and academic integrity quiz.
