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Background

Minors have been established within the University to provide opportunities for formal interschool study. Students must be enrolled in a degree program and must be in good standing to be eligible to take a Minor in another school. Upon successful completion of all requirements, the title of Minor Field of Study and the courses taken in support of the Field are entered on the student's transcript.

Minor in Nutrition Science

The Milken Institute School of Public Health (SPH) offers a minor in Nutrition Science through the Department of Exercise and Nutrition Sciences. Students completing the minor in Nutrition Science gain a deeper understanding of the science of nutrition. The minor in Nutrition Science consists of 18 credit hours. This minor provides a strong foundation in nutrition across the lifespan, in sport, and in public health. A 2.5 cumulative GPA or above is required for admittance. To earn the Nutrition Science minor, students are required to maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or above and earn a C- or above in all minor courses.
