We continue to follow University protocol in addition to local/national guidance in light of the ongoing pandemic. On 28 May 2020 the Office of the Vice President for Research (OVPR) issued an outline for research reopening with the stipulation that each school create a more refined action plan. The GWSPH Office of Research Excellence and Research Committee worked with faculty and staff to form five working groups who created the <u>GWSPH Research Reopening Guide</u>. The guidelines were created with four principles in mind:

- 1. The health and safety of our community is paramount.
- 2. Science, evidence, and pragmatism guide decisions.
- 3. Flexibility and innovation in the face of evolving circumstances.
- 4. Strive to provide inclusive and equitable solutions.

Research Initiation and Reopening Approval

Principal Investigators (PIs) who intend to initiate a new project or restart a halted project are *required to have an approved reopening plan*. PIs should carefully review the <u>instructions</u> before submitting the <u>GWSPH Research Project/Laboratory Initiation & Reopening Approval Form</u>. Both of these documents can be found on the COVID-19 Research webpage.

Forms must receive approval from your Department Chair before being sent to the ORE at <u>GWSPHResearch@gwu.edu</u>. The Senior Associate Dean for Research will review the request and consult with the Executive Associate Dean for Operations as needed. In addition, one request must be completed for *every* research project or laboratory.

The Office of Human Research (OHR) released guidance on 26 June 2020 for <u>Reopening Research during</u> <u>the COVID-19 Pandemic</u> that instructs schools to review all new research *and* existing projects that are restarting/reopening. As a result, all studies going to the GW IRB will need GWSPH approval first as stated above.
